## 80737ACT – Certificate II in Access 10 (Year 10 Alternative)

### What career options do I have?

On successful completion of this course you will then be able to access post Year 10 level courses, chosen employment or other career paths.

### What will I learn?

Access 10 is an equivalent Year 10 program which replaces Certificate II in Adult General Education in 2006.

Access 10 is self-paced with flexible entry and exit points. Students who have started, but not completed Certificate II in Adult General Education, should be able to transition into the Access 10 program.

This program provides an equivalent level of study to a school Year 10 within an adult education setting. It facilitates opportunities for further study including vocational education & training. It aims to develop literacy, numeracy, introductory science skills, computing, vocational & sociology skills to a recognised level of education.

### What qualification will I receive?

Certificate II in Access 10 or a Statement of Attainment for competencies achieved.

### Where will I train?

Mount Isa, Cloncurry, Lower Gulf

### How long will the training take?

Duration will depend on study mode selected.

### How will the training take place?

Part-time, day class Wed 9am – 12pm, evening classes Mon & Wed 6pm – 9pm or external (remote).

### What assessment methods will be used?

Assessments information is specified in the learning material provided.

Assessment methods generally vary according to skills content of competency. May include: short answer responses, observations, demonstrations, projects, discussions, group participation etc.

### Is there anything I need to bring?

A notebook and pen would be beneficial.

### Am I eligible?

Prior to enrolment, consider contacting the Client Information Centre who can discuss your personal preferences for training outcomes, or arrange for a teacher to discuss your learning pathway with you. As part of this discussion, the teacher may determine your skills readiness to enter the English and Mathematics core subjects and offer preparatory programs for skill development if needed.

### Is what I already know taken into account?

Yes. Your history of study, skills and experience does matter. Consideration is given to your life and work experiences as well as formal and informal training. This may be applied using the national standard for Mutual Recognition or through Recognition of Prior learning (RPL). Documentary evidence will be requested.

### When can I start? /How do I apply?

Contact the Client Information Centre for the latest course commencement dates and enrolment details.

### Can I go onto further training?

This course will also assist in preparation for the Certificate IV in Adult Tertiary Preparation or further study in other areas.

### What else might I find useful?

Financial assistance with fees may be available through concessions, or via 'Time to Pay' payment plan. This and other information such as Student Support, Study and Library Assistance, Student Responsibilities, is found in the Mount Isa Institute of TAFE Student Guide/ Handbook.
