



AUR20705 – Certificate II in Automotive (Air-conditioning) (RPL)

What career options do I have?

This qualification is the prerequisite qualification to gain an automotive air-conditioning licence. This program has been designed for people with previous work experience.

What qualification will I receive?

AUR20705 Certificate II in Automotive (Air-conditioning) or a Statement of Attainment for competencies achieved.

Where will I train?

Mount Isa.

How long will the training take?

The program length is 4 X 10 hour days – depending on your recognition of prior learning, educational and work experience you may not be required for the entire duration of the program.

How will the training take place?

The program will include Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) of prior work experience which will be complemented by additional theory and a practical assessment. Students will be asked to demonstrate their competence in all elements.

What assessment methods will be used?

Assessment methods generally vary according to skills content of competency. May include: short answer responses, observations, demonstrations, projects, discussions, group participation etc.

Is what I already know taken into account?

Yes. Your history of study, skills and experience does matter. Consideration is given to your life and work experiences as well as formal and informal training. This may be applied using the national standard for Mutual Recognition or through Recognition of Prior learning (RPL). Documentary evidence will be requested.

Am I eligible?

As this course is specifically designed for those with previous experience you will be asked to provide some documentation upon enrolment. Enrolments will not be accepted unless the **mandatory** documentation listed below is produced:

- ♦ An approved technicians handling licence (TAFE can assist you to obtain this licence or go to www.arctick.org)
- ♦ Certified copy of your Trade Certificate
- ♦ A letter of support from your employer with reference to your complete work history and competence with regard to air-conditioning
- ♦ Any previous air-conditioning qualifications, tickets or courses you have attended

Other desirable documentation:

- ♦ Certified copies of any post-trade qualifications (e.g. Certificate IV in Automotive, Automotive Technician, Diploma of Automotive etc)
- ♦ Complete lists of the units of competence you have completed (e.g. statement of attainment)
- ♦ Copy of temporary air-conditioning licence (experienced persons licence) or Air-Conditioning licence from a state other than Queensland
- ♦ Any relevant trade related qualifications from OEM's, e.g. Ford Registered Technician – Diagnostic

When can I start?/How do I apply?

No further training options available for this trade category.
