

CPCCOHS1001A: Work safely in the Construction Industry

What career options do I have?

Completion of the program meets the generic health and safety requirements to be employed on a construction site for construction type work or a prescribed activity such as removal of asbestos materials at a workplace.

What will I learn?

The unit is designed to meet OHS regulatory authority requirements for OHS induction and must be achieved before access to any building and construction work site.

What qualification will I receive?

Statement of Attainment for competencies achieved.

Where will I train?

Mount Isa, Lower Gulf, Cloncurry, On-Line or remotely.

How long will the training take?

4 -5 hours.

How will the training take place?

Training can take place in a formal classroom setting or participants in remote location can be sent package that allow students to complete the course.

What assessment methods will be used?

There are four chapters in this course each with an assessment task. You will have to complete True or False about safety obligations and common law. A Risk Assessment, questions about MSDS and a Cross Word about OHS response procedures. There is also a 32 multiple answer question relating to the over all induction.

Is what I already know taken into account?

Yes. Your history of study, skills and experience does matter. Consideration is given to your life and work experiences as well as formal and informal training. This may be applied using the national standard for Mutual Recognition or through Recognition of Prior learning (RPL). Documentary evidence will be requested.

When can I start? /How do I apply?

Contact the Client Information Centre for the latest course commencement dates and enrolment details.

Students will be required to bring photo identification to obtain their Construction Induction Card.

Can I go onto further training?

CPCCOHS1001A is a prerequisite for all compulsory OHS units in Certificate I, II and III construction qualifications. You may also gain recognition of your studies towards higher level training in this field.

Is there anything I need to bring?

A notebook and pen would be beneficial.
