39093QLD – Course in Electrical Installation, Inspection & Testing

What career options do I have?

This course will provide people with the technical qualification to apply to the Electrical Safety Office for an Electrical Contractors Licence to undertake Electrical Contracting in Queensland.

What will I learn?

This course will develop the technical skills and knowledge only as part of the Electrical Contractors Course. The course has been designed to review a range of procedures and requirements relating to electrical installations in accordance with Australian Standards and electrical installation, inspection and testing procedures.

What qualification will I receive?

Statement of Attainment for achievement of competence.

Where will I train?

This course will be conducted via videolining from Mount Isa Institute of TAFE to all participating sites. There will be a requirement to sit a practical assessment at your nearest Mount Isa or Central Queensland Institute of TAFE campus.

How long will the training take?

2 nights per week for 10 weeks plus a practical assessment during working hours.

How will the training take place?

Training will be both theoretical and practical including simulated live work. There will also be a theoretical and practical assessment.

Students that have not worked via Video Conference before will receive a brief training session during the first class. Any further support or information that is required outside of classes can be obtained by contacting the teacher, Bob Kalik on 4744 9966.

What assessment methods will be used?

Assessment methods will be both theoretical and practical.

Is there anything I need to bring?

The electrical standards: AS3000 & AS3008. A workbook will be provided for study purposes.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for enrolment, you must hold a Queensland electrical licence as an Electrical Mechanic, Electrical Fitter and Mechanic, or Engineering Tradesperson (Electrical).

Pre-requisite:

Must provide proof of current first aid – apply resuscitation techniques (QASFA01) or equivalent.

Is what I already know taken into account?

If you have held your electrical licence for under five (5) years, you are not required to complete this course. In accordance with Electrical Safety Office Licensing requirements this course is specifically designed for people who have been licensed for more than 5 years.

When can I start?/How do I apply?

Contact the Client Information Centre for enrolment details and course commencement dates.

Can I go onto further training?

To meet the requirements of a qualified Business person please refer to the Electrical Safety Office website. Upon completion of this course there will be an opportunity to complete an approved management course for more information please contact your local Client Information Centre.
